-Parent Resources Discussion- The Superintendent wants to add parent resources on the district website and was asking for input from the committee. The committee reviewed the Valley website and agreed that parents would like help with ways to access math resources, access to the new reading program and how to test on-line. It was brought up that we need to add Clever to the Valley website as well.

-Traffic Safety-New Pick-up routes. Pick-up and drop-off traffic was discussed. We need to create an easement for the buses. It was suggested that we use the field and create a one-way drive around the field entering on 100 E and exiting on the hwy behind the Fire Department. It was discussed how to keep the buses on the blacktop/out of the

pick-up line and keep students from having to cross traffic to board the buses. The buses would enter the field on 100 E and wrap around the portables and then exit out 100 E.

The playground and the propane will have to be moved to make this happen. Mary will speak with the administration about these options.
