Completed Projects Under Current Admin- School Wellness Room, Restored School Plays, Assemblies to promote the arts, music, and local talent, Academic Assemblies, Updated basketball poles and hoops on blacktop, Mental Health Awareness/Suicide Prevention rocks (East of Playground), Updated HVAC System, Updated Bell System, after school coding club, Math Recess (Joeie), 3rd Grade garden, STEM lab (also used for Lego League), with a restroom for after school activities, Student Council involved with school projects, Family STEM projects for checkout (in front of school). Additional Reading/Math Lab.

<u>This Year Projects-</u> Updated sprinkling system (added alternate flag pole for interim). Add another 6 foot hoop for "full-court" play for K-2. Add **bridge** over wash where trail connects with Nick Hoyt's property for an outdoor learning area. Include student input in this project through STEM activities. Close open gates around the building (Utah code, these gates will be locked during school hours to ensure student safety and will unlock after school).

- <u>1-2 Year Plan-</u> Switch pick up and bus zones, move cross walk to corner of street along highway (one way 110 East 30 min before and after school). Add a drinking fountain to the STEM lab. Healthy grass field. Continue to meet our SIP Goals. Outdoor Learning Space completed.
- <u>3 Year Plan-</u> Offer after school programs with 4-H throughout the school year and summers. Continue to meet our SIP Goals. Number line on black top, State Counties on black top.

<u>5 Year Plan-</u> Work with town council to upgrade playground equipment, add a walking track, Continue to meet our SIP Goals. United States on Blacktop, Periodic Table on blacktop.
